Happy New Year!



I know that it is not January 1^{st} yet – but we began our new church year on November 27^{th} , the first Sunday of Advent. We begin our new year with the end of the story as we prepare for the return of Jesus.

Why do we start our Christian year with the end of the story? Why nor start with the birth of Jesus and move through the year progressively? What difference does it make when you know the end of the story? I know – I am asking more questions than I am offering answers, but Advent is a time when we reflect on what it means to prepare our hearts to receive Jesus.
